Action Requested: Implement Required Comprehensive Sexual Health Education Grades

6-12.

Brief Explanation:

Requirements for delivering comprehensive Sexual Health Education for Grades 6-12, whether offered via an online or classroom-based learning model, are outlined below. Completion of this instruction fulfills CA Education Code requirements for comprehensive sexual health education and follows California Department of Education guidelines to implement all required instruction even if instruction transitions to online learning. Principals will identify teachers of existing courses to attend professional development and implement the required curriculum during the school year.

The Board-approved *Rights, Respect, Responsibility* curriculum will be implemented online or in the classroom in Grades 6 and 8 by designated teachers, and in high school Biology (inclusive of students in Grades 9-12) or in another content area taught to all Grade 10 students. See chart below for instructional details.

Per SDUSD, if a previously trained Sex Ed teacher is new to teaching the online curriculum, they must participate in a professional development prior to implementing the online *Rights, Respect, Responsibility* curriculum. Details about this professional development will be communicated to previously trained Sex Ed teachers by the Sexual Health Education Program.
